STABLE RULES

General – All clients

- 1) All clients **must wear a riding hat** whenever they ride *or lunge* anywhere on the premises.
- 2) All clients **must wear a body protector** when they ride in the Centre's cross country course.
- 3) All accidents must be reported and the accident recorded in the accident book..
- 4) No smoking is allowed anywhere on the yard or the Groomery, other than in the designated smoking areas in the car parks.
- 5) Please read and abide by the Centre's **safety and fire** regulations.
- 6) All Clients are requested to be tidy and safe around the yard i.e. do not pick feet out on the yard, do not leave things on the yard, put away what you use, close gates and doors, etc.
- 7) Standard "use of schools" rules apply, i.e. please give warning prior to entering or leaving, no lunging except by prior agreement of other users, pass left to left, give warning if riding a young or difficult horse etc.
- 8) Please turn off stable / school lights after use.
- 9) **Instructors:** We do not allow the use of third parties instructors, this service to be supplied by the Centre.
- 10) If you bring **children** then you are responsible for their behaviour and safety at all times. No child under 16 may be left at the yard without a parent without prior agreement with **yard manager**
- 11) All gates onto the yard must be kept closed and closed immediately after use.
- 12) Dogs to be kept on leads at all times please. The Centre reserves the right to ban any dog.
- 13) Cars to be parked safely and locked at all times, in the car park area. The Centre accepts no liability for cars parked on the premises. If the front car park is full park in the back car park, driving carefully through the yard. **Do not block entrances.**
- 14) No horse boxes to be parked, or horses loaded/ unloaded, on the yard or in the front car park. Use the back car park.

Livery Clients – additional rules

- 1) Any equipment must be clearly marked.
- 2) Clients must declare prior to arrival any habits / vices or unpredictable behaviour.
- 3) Clients must abide by the worming programme as set by the yard manager. All horses will be wormed on arrival. When a horse is wormed it must remain stabled for a period of 48 hrs.
- 4) Clients may come at any time between 8:00 am and 7:30 pm, assuming a **member of staff is on duty**. Clients may not ride or attend their horse when the yard is closed or if no member of staff is on duty. Please note we expect you to finish riding and be off the yard by these times.
- 5) The Centre is insured for third party cover with NFU Mutual but will not be responsible for accidental injury or health problems for individual horses or for loss of private property. Clients are strongly advised to have individual accident / health / third party / property insurance.
- 6) Jumps, dressage boards, letters can be used at any time but must be put away, and any breakages paid for.

Riding School Clients – additional rules

- 1) Lessons – all clients must undertake an assessment session before regular lessons commence, this will include emergency details in case of an accident.
- 2) Lessons must be booked and paid for *in advance*. Call the yard to book a lesson (01344-884992) or book in person.
- 3) Cancellations – no refund will be given for lessons cancelled with less than 24 hours' notice.
- 4) Clients must turn up at the agreed time for a lesson, whilst the Centre will try and be flexible; if a client is late no refund will be given and the lesson may be shorter than the booked time..
- 5) Minimum age for lessons is 4. Parents should remain at the Centre when young children have lessons.
- 6) Whilst every effort will be made to ensure you have your selected instructor and horse the Centre reserves the right to switch either if necessary.
- 7) Riding is a dangerous sport, whilst every effort will be made to be safe, accidents can happen. The Centre cannot take responsibility for accidents and a condition of taking lessons here is that you accept this. We advise you to have your own insurance for this sport.
